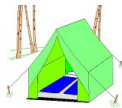

**Am I expected to give all of my time, talent, and treasure to the Church?** No, giving of time, talent, and treasure is not limited to the Church. Most people give of their time and talent as volunteers to human service agencies in the community in addition to volunteering in the Church. That volunteer work in the community could still be done in conjunction with the Church, such as when a group of parishioners volunteer their time at a homeless shelter, or it could be done separate and apart from the Church, such as when an individual serves on an agency board.

Many people will give money to other community groups in addition to supporting the Church. Some may give 80 percent of their stewardship of treasure to church-related causes and 20 percent to community groups, such as soup kitchen. Others may give 50 percent to the Church and 50 percent to groups in the community.
