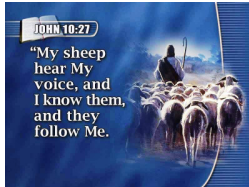

Why is it important to renew our commitment to stewardship of time, talent, and treasure on an annual basis in the parish?

A reminder to all teachers and aides—please return your teachers manuals. They need to be inventoried for next year. Thank you!



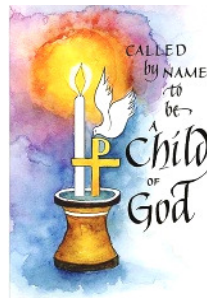
