- ✦ The meeting began with the ongoing exercise to discern and define the core values of our parish.
- ✦ The blood drive was a great success. 16 units of blood were collected.
- ✦ The Fall Picnic/Festival has been planned for late September and activities are still in the works by the planning committee.
- ✦ Several building issue have been addressed and fixed. There is a plan on putting together a Building Maintenance Committee for building oversight.
- ✦ The Council continues to explore options for a permanent St. Patrick Catholic Church sign.
- ✦ A new Director of RE has been selected and her start date is 6/21/10. An application has been submitted to the Austin Dioceses for St. Patrick to host an Ethics and Integrity workshop. The tentative dates will be the end of August or September.
- ✦ The Council is continuing to take suggestion on putting together Church Pictorial Book.
