Our Lord told us, "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."(Mt. 19:14) Children have the same right as adults to be in church. We should always encourage them to be there. As they become used to being in church, their behavior will improve. The purpose of the "Quiet Room" at St Patrick is for a parent to utilize the room during a time when the child is upset/crying. Once the child has become quiet and content, the parent is to return to worshipping with the rest of the assembly in the main worship space. It is not a place to remain. By following this practice, it will allow more parents access to the room when it is needed.
